The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity **Sunday, May 27th, 2018**

This week we return to the liturgical season of Ordinary Time. Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity.

Pope Francis spoke about the love that is at the heart of the divine life of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. It is, he said, "a life of profound communion and perfect love, the origin and end of the whole universe and of every creature."

But the Holy Trinity is also the model of the Church "in which we are called to love one another as Jesus has loved us." Love, Pope Francis said, is the distinctive mark of the Christian.

As Christians, "we are called to bear witness to and announce the message that 'God is love,' that God is not distant or insensible to our human affairs." God, the Pope said, "is close to us, He is always by our side, He walks with us to share our joys and our sorrows, our hopes and our struggles." He loves human beings so much that He sent His only Son, the Second Person of the Trinity, into the world, that the world might be saved through Jesus. It is the Holy Spirit, the gift of the Risen Jesus, that communicates the divine life to us and so makes us enter into the dynamism of the Trinity, a dynamism of love, of communion, of reciprocal service, of sharing." A person, a family, a parish that loves others for the sake of love is a "reflection of the Trinity."
